About the project

The Tall Tree Wind Farm is a proposed renewable energy project, located within the proposed Central Highlands Renewable Energy Zone (REZ) in Central West Victoria. The project has the potential to generate enough energy to power up to 250,000 homes annually, with up to 53 wind turbines on site. The site was chosen due to its strong wind resource, open, undulating terrain, nearby port access and proximity to a strong grid connection.

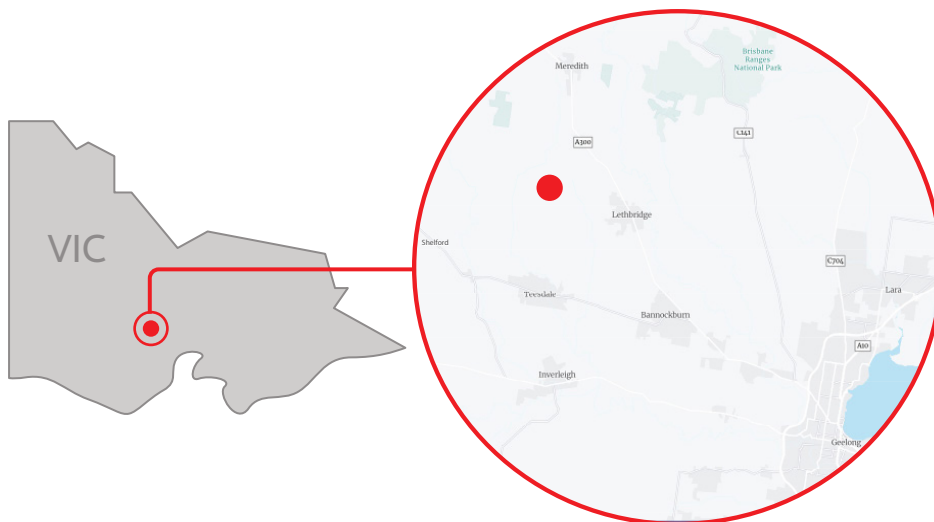

JOB AND LOCAL ECONOMY

As part of the proposed Tall Tree Wind Farm, ACCIONA Energía will create up to 270 construction jobs. In the operations phase, we'll need a team of 10- 12 staff to maintain and operate the project over its multi-decade lifespan.



PROCUREMENT AND SUPPLIER OPPORTUNITIES

Our procurement policy aims to source as much work and supply as possible from local businesses, ensuring economic growth and development opportunities that benefit local communities first. From earthworks to catering, we want to work with local people to supply our projects.



COMMUNITY INVESTMENT PROGRAM

We will establish a co-designed community investment program to support the wider community. Whether through legacy projects, energy subsidies or grant schemes, these investments will be developed and tailored to support local residents. We will also offer scholarships to local students to progress to tertiary education.



NEIGHBOURHOOD BENEFIT PROGRAM

The proposed program delivers annual benefits between \$1,250 and \$10,000 during the project's operational period (typically up to 30 years) to eligible residents with a dwelling within 2.5km of a turbine.

Anticipated timeline

The Tall Tree Wind Farm project has been referred in mid 2025 to the Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) for consideration under the Environment Effects Act 1978, and is awaiting the Victorian Planning Minister's decision if the project is required to complete an Environment Effects Statement.
